REGISTER TODAY!

Register for Kid Zone between July 29-August 5, and pay a \$0 registration fee—a savings of up to \$45.

Plus a one-time annual \$45 non-refundable registration fee per family.

Kid Zone payments will be paid monthly via automatic withdrawal from a checking account or debit/credit card. Participants may start attending Kid Zone four business days after the day registration is completed.

\*Please Note: The Greater Joliet Area YMCA will make every reasonable effort to accommodate children with special needs, however, our Kid Zone Program is a Youth Recreation Program and is not equipped to handle children that require 1:1 attention on a regular basis. Any child requiring 1:1 care on a regular basis may not be suitable for this type of program and will not be able to utilize our services.

### DAYS OUT OF SCHOOL/HOLIDAY BREAKS

The Kid Zone program operates on days when school is in session. On full days out of school, including snow days and holiday breaks, the Y offers a Day Out of School program from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. at the YMCA.

On Days Out of School, all participants should dress for the weather, bring a sack lunch, a drink, snacks, swimsuit and a towel. Cost is \$38 per day for Facility Members and \$53 per day for Community Members.

**Please Note:** The C,W, Avery Family YMCA's Kid Zone Program will only operate in the morning on the last half day of school before Winter Break and the last half day of school before Summer Break.

### REPORTING ABSENCES

If for any reason (including illness) your child will NOT be attending the AFTER SCHOOL program, YOU MUST CALL the YMCA Kid Zone site phone before 2:30 p.m. to notify the staff. The YMCA staff members at your child's school will check the site phones daily to document any absences. Failure to report absences 3 or more times may result in removal from the program.

**Please Note:** We cannot deduct days missed from your fee (Please refer to the Refund and Credit Policy).

### 5 HOUR DAYS/EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS

On 5 Hour Days of School, children enrolled in the YMCA's Kid Zone **After School** program have the opportunity to participate in a field trip for an additional fee. Children that do not attend the field trip will need to be picked up at dismissal time, or ride the bus home.

The YMCA will choose destinations that are age-appropriate for all Kid Zone participants. Field trips will be announced 1-2 weeks prior to the trip. Permission slips will be distributed to students. Due to staff scheduling requirements, prepaid admission and transportation arrangements, we ask that all permission slips be turned into Kid Zone staff by the registration deadline. **Late registration forms will not be accepted.**

If your child participates in the field trip, they will need to bring a sack lunch. Field trips will run from approximately 2-5 p.m. After returning to the school, snacks will be provided.
