How do you sign up for the summer reading program?

Please go to: [scholastic.com/homebase](https://www.scholastic.com/homebase) to create your child's personal account. Students will have a home base where they can unlock new books, play games inspired by popular books, create short stories and comics, and many other activities.

At the end of the program students will be asked to print their reading log from the Scholastic site and turn them into their classroom teacher. Students may also use the reading log that is attached. Mrs. Brophy and Mrs. Gellert will look at all reading logs. The winners will be announced in September.
