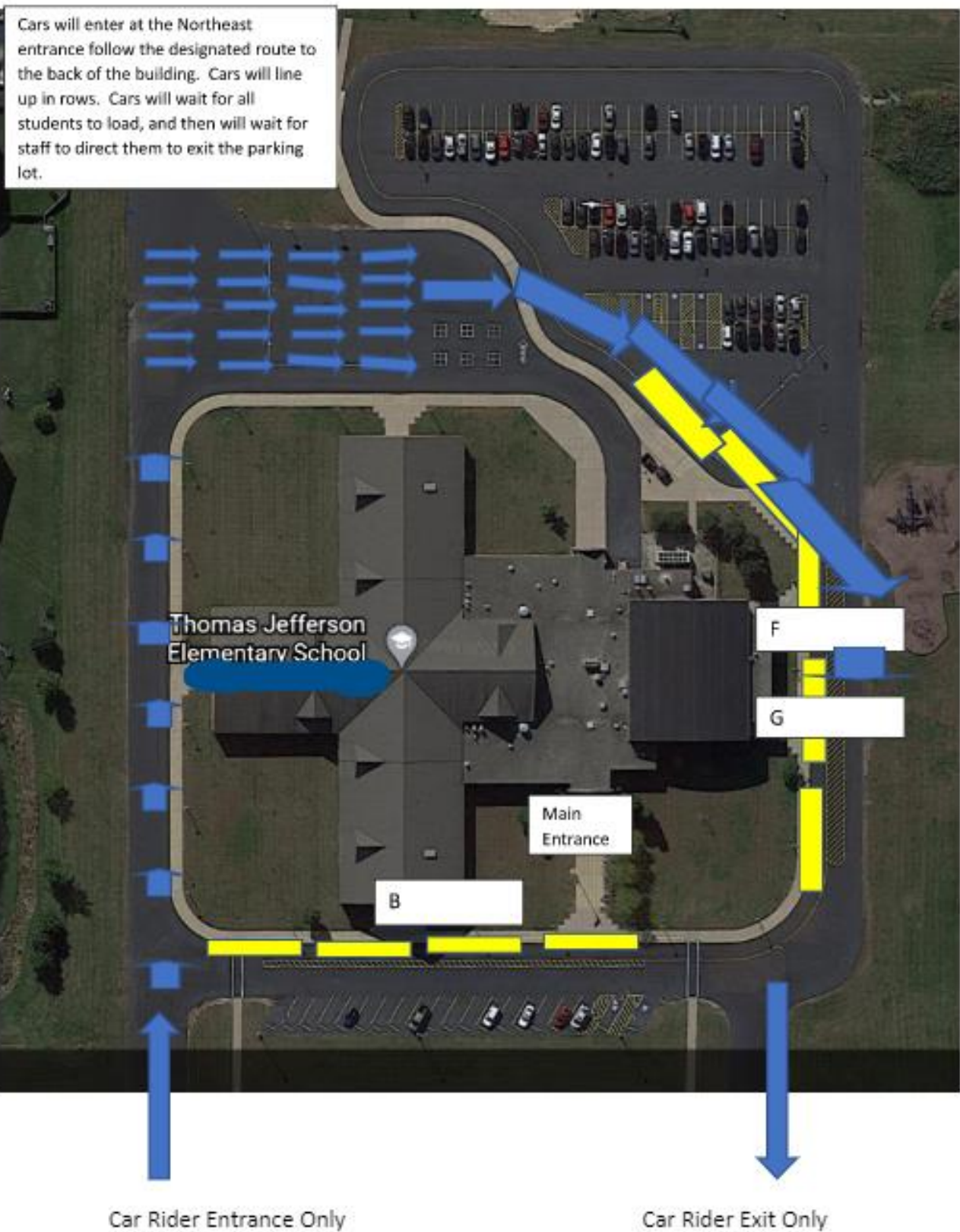




Thomas Jefferson Dismissal Procedures




Thomas Jefferson Dismissal Procedures

Car Riders – Enter through the Northeast entrance. Follow the designated route to the back of the building. Cars will line up in rows. We encourage you to turn off your cars while students are dismissed. Staff will dismiss cars when it is safe to exit the parking lot. Staff will wait for all students to load into the cars before dismissing cars. Once all students are in their cars, staff will direct rows to exit the parking lot by the marquee/Northwest exit. The first row to dismiss will be the row along the sidewalk furthest from the school building. 

Multi-Needs Program – Enter through the Northwest entrance by the marquee and proceed to the front of the building Door B. 

Walkers – Enter and exit through the main entrance.

Bus Riders - Will enter and exit through Doors F & G. Daycare buses will exit from Door Special education buses will enter and exit at Door B. 

ADDITIONAL SAFETY GUIDELINES

Please call the office prior to 2:30 if there are any changes in dismissal for your child. Children will be dismissed the way they are always dismissed unless the office is notified of any change from a parent/guardian.

Please be aware that it is **illegal to talk on cell phones while driving through a school speed zone** or a construction zone – unless using a hands-free device or a speaker phone is enabled – except in cases of emergency to contact law enforcement, health care providers, fire department and other emergency response personnel. It is also now illegal to compose, send or read text messages, read or compose e-mail, look at the internet or otherwise compose or send any type of electronic message while driving.
